



Camp Programs

Campers will be divided into groups according to their experience. Campers will ride, handle horses every day and discover what makes the equine species so unique. Activities will be age appropriate.

Full-Day Camp: Ages 8-14

Monday - Friday: 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

Cost: \$475.00 per week

Half-Day Camp: Ages 6-14

Monday - Friday: 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.

Cost: \$400.00 per week

Equipment

All campers must have the following items:

- A properly fitted ASTM/SEI approved horseback riding helmet **(provided)**
- Hard-soled shoe or boot with a one-inch heel **(provided)**
- Long pants (campers will not be allowed to ride in shorts or sneakers: jeans or stretch pants are fine if you do not have breeches.
- Water bottle
- Bag for personal belongings
- All Campers need to bring a snack. Full day campers need to bring lunch.
- Bathing suit, towel, and bag for full day camp.

Morning Activities

8.30 – 9.00 Check-in and welcome (riders are fitted with boots and helmets). Riders meet counsellors and other campers.

9:00 Riding and ground lessons begin. When not riding, campers participate in ground lessons e.g. horse safety, grooming, tacking, parts of the tack, parts of the horse, colors and markings, breeds, horse behavior etc. All ground lessons include practical skills (working with the horses) and games to reinforce skills learned.

10:30 Snack break. Campers should bring a (refillable) water bottle and a healthy snack. Ice pops are provided.

11:15 Riding and ground lessons continue. A different art or craft is completed every day.

12.45 – 1.00 Clean-up and pick-up for half day campers



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Afternoon Activities (full day campers only)

1.00 Lunch break.

The afternoon consists of two sessions – A horse activity and a swimming session (pool is on the farm).

1:30 – 3.00 Horse Activity (Group 1) / Swimming (Group 2)

3.00 – 4.30 Horse Activity (Group 2) / Swimming (Group 1)

Afternoon horse activities include but are not limited to leading a horse through an obstacle course, horse scavenger hunt, bareback riding, horse bathing, vet/farrier demonstrations etc. Due to the nature of activities and the dependency on weather conditions, planned activities may change without notice.

4.45 - 5:00 - Pick up for full day campers

On Friday morning, parents are invited to attend a 45-minute session to watch riders demonstrate the skills they have practiced during their week at camp. Parents are given the opportunity to take photos of riders with their horses.
