Schooling Jumpers are those schooling jumper courses at 2', 2'3, or 2'6 (2'9 or 3' upon request) 4 faults for each rail down, 4 faults for every refusal, 1 fault for every second over the maximum time allowed to negotiate the course

23. Schooling Jumper Optimum Time
24. Schooling Jumper Table II Sec.2a
(Jump off takes place after entrant has completed first round)
25. Schooling Jumper Speed Round Table II Sec.1 (Fastest trip with a clear round wins)

Riders' hunter over fences score in their Short Stirrup/Long Stirrup/Hopeful Hunter Class will count as the starting score. Derby Rounds will go at the end of each division. **Entry fee \$25 – all proceeds go to the team.**
