

### **Covered Ring- start 8:30am**

**Lead Line** is open to riders 9 years and under who are not quite ready to ride solo. Helmet required, leaders must be attached to the horse, a walker is required to lead each entry. No trotting will be required. Riders will be judged on elementary fundamentals of horsemanship. All breeds and all disciplines are welcome.

**Walk-Trot** division is for walk trot riders who are in their first two years of showing.

2. Walk-Trot Equitation
3. Walk- Trot Hunter Under Saddle
4. Walk-Trot Over Poles

**Walk Trot Canter** division is for those ready to compete at the canter in a group.

5. Walk-Trot-Canter Equitation
6. Walk-Trot-Canter Hunter Under Saddle
7. Walk-Trot- Canter Over Poles

### **Front Ring- starts at 8:30**

**Crossrails** riders are to be in their first two years showing over fences - martingale/bell boots allowed if needed

8. Crossrails Equitation Over Fences
9. Crossrails Hunter Over Fences
10. Crossrails Hunter Under Saddle
11. Crossrails Equitation On The Flat

**Short and Long Stirrup** (will combine if not enough entries in either) riders show a course with a change of direction - martingale/bell boots allowed if needed

12. Short/Long Stirrup Equitation Over Fences
13. Short/Long Stirrup Hunter Over Fences
14. Short/Long Stirrup Hunter Under Saddle
15. Short/Long Stirrup Equitation On The Flat

**\*\*Hopeful Hunter** riders show a course with a change of direction, martingale/bell boots allowed if needed

16. Hopeful Hunter Equitation Over Fences
17. Hopeful Hunter Over Fences
18. Hopeful Hunter Under Saddle
19. Hopeful Hunter Equitation On The Flat

**\*\*Will cancel if not enough entries**

**\*\*Schooling Jumpers** are those schooling jumper courses starting at 2'  
4 faults for each rail down, 4 faults for every refusal, 1 fault for every second over time allowed

20. Schooling Jumper Optimum Time
21. Schooling Jumper Table II Sec.2a  
(Jump off takes place after entrant has completed first round)
22. Schooling Jumper Speed Round Table II Sec.1 (Fastest trip with a clear round wins)
